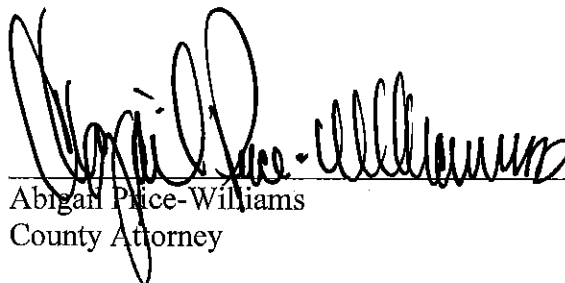

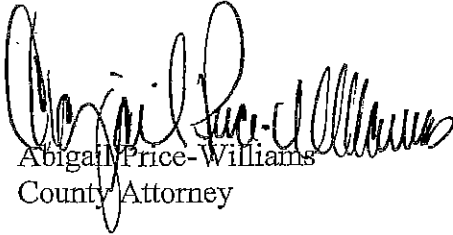

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SW
60TH COURT (TROPICAL WAY) FROM SW 30TH STREET
TO SW 33RD STREET AS "DR. RICHARD ZAKHEIM WAY"

WHEREAS, Dr. Richard Zakheim was born on February 26, 1937 in New York City and received his medical degree from Albert Einstein Medical School in New York; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Zakheim served as a pediatrician and cardiologist at the Malcolm Grow USAF Medical Center at Andrews Air Force Base in Washington, D.C., and then as Director of the Pediatric Cardiology Program at the University of Texas Health Science Center; and

WHEREAS, in 1977 Dr. Zakheim moved to Miami and founded the Pediatric Cardiology Department at Miami Children's Hospital, which was renamed Nicklaus Children's Hospital in 2015. In 2006 Dr. Zakheim also founded the Adult Congenital Heart Disease Clinic at the hospital; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his dedicated service at Nicklaus Children's Hospital, where he worked until April 2015, Dr. Zakheim and his wife Pamela co-founded the Wellness Community-Greater Miami (now Cancer Support Community Greater Miami) in 1999, where he volunteered his time and expertise since its opening; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2015, Dr. Zakheim passed away at the age of 78; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor the memory of Dr. Zakheim and his contributions to the community by codesignating that portion of SW 60th Court (Tropical Way) from SW 30th Street to SW 33rd Street as "Dr. Richard Zakheim Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of SW 60th Court (Tropical Way) from SW 30th Street to SW 33rd Street is a County road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Nicklaus Children’s Hospital is located at 3100 SW 62nd Avenue; and
WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,
NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of SW 60th Court (Tropical Way) from SW 30th Street to SW 33rd Street as “Dr. Richard Zakheim Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Public Works and Waste Management Department, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
