Report on the Amount of Garbage Produced and Water Used Per Person - Directive

At the June 15, 2015 Strategic Planning and Government Operations Committee meeting, Commissioner Juan C. Zapata directed the Administration to prepare and submit a report on the amount of garbage produced and water used per person.

During calendar year 2014, the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department used 135 gallons per capita per day.

The most accurate waste generation data available is Public Works and Waste Management Department (PWWM) scale and Waste Collection System data contained in the PWWM's Waste Management Enterprise Fund Comprehensive Annual Financial Report for Fiscal Year 2013-14. This data relates to waste collection in the Solid Waste Collection Service Area (SWCSA), which includes the Unincorporated Municipal Service Area (UMSA) and the eight (8) cities served by PWWM for waste collection. This approach to determining waste generation per person uses the number of households served in the SWCSA and the corresponding tons collected by PWWM. Using a U.S. census figure for persons per household in Miami-Dade County (County), we are able to determine the pounds per person per day generated at the household level (refer to the table below).

The resulting 4.05 pounds/person/day figure is in line with the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) nationwide figure of 4.40 pounds/person/day contained in their "Advancing Sustainable Materials Management: 2013 Fact Sheet," published in June of 2015.

The Florida Department of Environmental Protection (FDEP) figure of 7.63 pounds/person/day, contained in it's "Solid Waste Management in Florida 2014 Annual Report," however, varies significantly from the PWWM and USEPA result. This is because the FDEP figure includes all waste generated in the County, meaning all residential uses (e.g. single family homes, multi-family buildings/condominiums, etc.) and all commercial uses (e.g. retail stores, restaurants, offices, hotels, manufacturing facilities). FDEP divides their 2014 figure for total waste managed in the County by means of combustion, landfilling, and recycling (3,640,363 tons) by the County population estimate (2,613,692) to arrive at the pounds per person per day or pounds per capita per day.
