RESOLUTION NO.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING COUNTY POLICY THAT ANY ANTICIPATED SAVINGS FROM THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE PROPOSED BUS SERVICE **ADJUSTMENTS** SCHEDULED TO COMMENCE IN NOVEMBER, 2017, DETERMINED BY CALCULATING THE AMOUNT OF FUNDING THAT EXCEEDS THE AMOUNT NECESSARY TO MAINTAIN THE ADJUSTED LEVEL OF SERVICES AFTER ACCOUNTING FOR PROJECTED CHANGES IN REVENUES AND **EXPENDITURES** SHALL BE BUDGETED AS ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE STRATEGIC MIAMI AREA RAPID TRANSIT ("SMART") PLAN IN THE DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND PUBLIC WORK'S TRANSIT **OPERATING** BUDGET; DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO INCLUDE IMPLEMENTATION OF SAID POLICY IN THE PROPOSED 2017-2018 FISCAL YEAR BUDGET, AS WELL AS ALL SUBSEQUENT PROPOSED BUDGETS UNTIL THE IMPLEMENTATION OF THE SMART PLAN IS COMPLETED

WHEREAS, Section 2-1795 of the Code of Miami-Dade County requires the County

Mayor to submit a proposed budget for approval by the Board of County Commissioners in a

line-item format with schedules for specific expenditures; and

WHEREAS, the County Mayor has recommended proposed bus service adjustments in

order to obtain greater efficiencies and cost savings; and

WHEREAS, the Strategic Miami Area Rapid Transit ("SMART") Plan includes the

construction of six new rapid transit corridors throughout Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, funding the implementation of the SMART Plan is critical to improving the

chronic traffic congestion in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, applying the anticipated savings from the proposed bus service adjustments to the SMART Plan implementation will help fund the expansion of Miami-Dade County's transit system as well as demonstrate to the federal and state government that the County is committed to the SMART Plan,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. This Board establishes as a County policy that any anticipated savings from the implementation of the proposed bus service adjustments scheduled to commence in November, 2017, determined by calculating the amount of funding that exceeds the amount necessary to maintain the adjusted level of services after accounting for projected changes in revenues and expenditures shall be budgeted as additional funding for the implementation of the SMART Plan in the Department of Transportation and Public Work's Transit operating budget.

Section 2. This Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to include implementation of said policy in the proposed 2017-2018 budget submitted to this Board for approval, as well as all subsequent proposed budgets submitted for this Board's approval until the implementation of the SMART Plan is completed.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Chairman Esteban L. Bovo, Jr. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
