Subject: Recommendation for Approval to ~~Reject~~ All Proposals for Fiber Optic Cable System

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the rejection of all proposals received under *Request for Proposals No. RFP-00569, Fiber Optic Cable System*.

The County issued a solicitation under full and open competition to provide a fiber optic cable system (System) for twelve transportation priority corridors. The selected proposer would have been responsible for the design, engineering, installation, construction, maintenance, and management of the System. The System would be used to provide telecommunications data service for Intelligent Transportation Systems devices, which manage intelligent traffic controllers, vehicle detectors, and integrate camera feeds to automate incident detection and assist with event management.

Two proposals were received in response to the solicitation. Prior to the evaluation of proposals, the Department of Transportation and Public Works decided a revision of scope was necessary to leverage emerging technologies, expand the scope beyond the twelve transportation priority corridors, and to allow proposers to offer the latest communication technology based on the County's functional requirements. A revised Request for Proposal will be issued in the near future that incorporates the necessary changes.

Scope

The scope of this item would have been countywide in nature.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

There is no fiscal impact to the County for the rejection of proposals.


