

RESOLUTION APPROVING DISPLAY IN RECOGNITION OF THE ANNIVERSARY OF THE AMERICANS WITH DISABILITIES ACT IN THE STEPHEN P. CLARK CENTER SECURED LOBBY AREA PURSUANT TO RESOLUTION NO. R-240-16; DECLARING JULY 2018 AND THE MONTH OF JULY FOR EACH YEAR THEREAFTER AS DISABILITY DIVERSITY MONTH

WHEREAS, on July 26, 1990, the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (“ADA”) was signed into law by President George H. W. Bush; and

WHEREAS, the ADA is the federal civil rights law that prohibits discrimination based on disability in employment, state and local government services, public accommodations and commercial facilities, and telecommunications; and

WHEREAS, people with disabilities still face many challenges, including poverty, unemployment, and the pervasiveness of discrimination that favors the non-disabled and devalues people with disabilities; and

WHEREAS, despite these challenges, people with disabilities have achieved great things and continue to live rich, full, and meaningful lives; and

WHEREAS, the diversity of disability deserves to be acknowledged and celebrated; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to recognize the anniversary of the passage of the ADA and celebrate the diversity of disability,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves a display recognizing the ADA in the “Secured Lobby Area” as that term is defined in Resolution No. R-240-16 during the month of July 2018.

Section 2. Declares the month of July 2018, and the month of July for each year thereafter, as Disability Diversity Month in Miami-Dade County.


