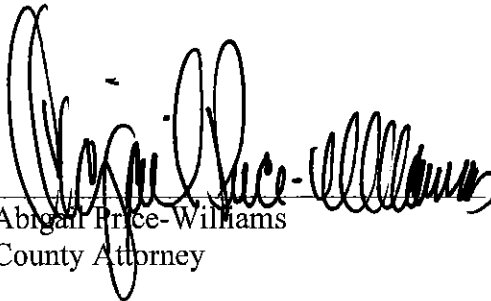

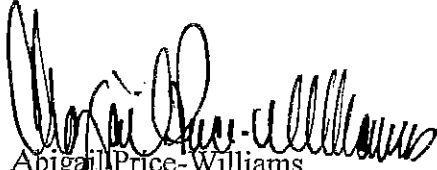

WHEREAS, the Gloria M. Silverio Foundation has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the March 10, 2018 "Safe Haven for Newborns 5K Walk" in an amount not to exceed \$784.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and
