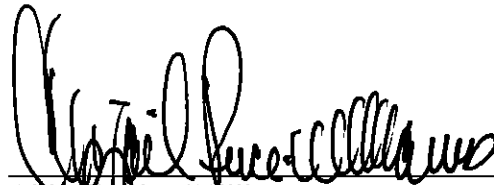

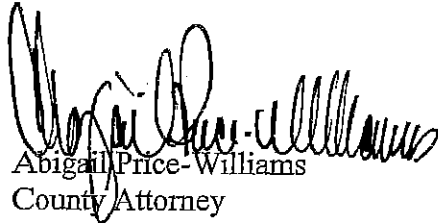

RESOLUTION RETROACTIVELY AUTHORIZING IN-KIND SERVICES FROM THE PARKS, RECREATION AND OPEN SPACES DEPARTMENT FOR THE MARCH 24, 2018 “5TH ANNUAL STOP THE VIOLENCE AND BRING THE PEACE” EVENT SPONSORED BY THE INNER CITY YOUTH ENRICHMENT CAMP, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$1,070.00 TO BE FUNDED FROM THE BALANCE OF THE DISTRICT 3 FY 2017-18 IN-KIND RESERVE FUND

WHEREAS, the Inner City Youth Enrichment Camp, Inc. has requested in-kind services from the Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department for the March 24, 2018 “5th Annual Stop the Violence and Bring the Peace” event in an amount not to exceed \$1,070.00 (see attached Fee Waiver/In-kind Service Application); and
