Resolution Authorizing Submittal of a Grant Application to Florida Inland Navigation District, Waterways Assistance Program (FIND) for up to \$38,600.00 with Matching

County Funds of up to \$97,100.00 for Pelican Harbor Marina Fishing Pier - 1 (Design &

Permitting) to Reconstruct a Demolished Fishing Pier.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorize the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to apply to Florida Inland Navigation District's Waterways Assistance Program (FIND) for up to \$38,600.00, with matching county funds of up to \$97,100.00, for Phase 1 to reconstruct a demolished fishing pier at Pelican Harbor Marina. It is further recommended that the Board authorize the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to receive and expend funds and execute grant agreements, certain amendments and other documents as required by the grant agreement upon review and final approval of the County Attorney's Office for legal sufficiency.

Scope

Pelican Harbor Marina is located at 1275 NE 79 Street, Miami, in County Commission District 3, which is represented by Chairwoman Audrey M. Edmonson.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The project will reconstruct a demolished fishing pier at Pelican Harbor Marina. The County's estimate of for Phase 1 (Design & Permitting) costs is \$135,700.00. The FIND estimated total project cost of \$38,600.00 shown on the resolution is less because FIND disallows in-house costs, such as project management, bidding and contracting costs, from the grant program. Thus, the maximum FIND grant is 50 percent of FIND's allowed project costs. If awarded, the FIND grant will provide funds of up to \$38,600.00. The County will provide \$97,100.00 from the Florida Boating Improvement Program Vessel Fees Allocation Fund, index code PRE130935014. The County match provides funding sufficient to complete the project. This project solely reconstructs a demolished fishing pier; therefore, no additional operating cost will be incurred by the County resulting from completion of this project.

Track Record/Monitor

FIND's Waterway Assistance Program has awarded to Miami-Dade County Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces Department (PROS) over \$5,000,000.00 in grants since 2012. The proposed grant will be administered by PROS Acting Grants Manager Dorothy Mills-Mayers.

Background

FIND is a Special Taxing District for the continued management and maintenance of the Atlantic Intracoastal Waterway. FIND grant projects must be related to the Florida Intracoastal Waterway. The application is due to be mailed by March 27, 2020 and is required to be accompanied by an adopted resolution. If awarded, the grant term will begin October 2020 and end September 2022. The project is scheduled to be completed within the grant term, but, if needed, a one-year extension is allowed upon request.

As part of the application process, it is required that a resolution be adopted in substantially the form of this resolution by the applicant for FIND grant funds. Amendments will only be made in conformance with this resolution where no additional matching funds or other County funds are encumbered, otherwise Board approval will be required to make amendments to the grant.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SUBMITTAL OF A GRANT APPLICATION TO THE FLORIDA INLAND NAVIGATION DISTRICT, (FIND) WATERWAYS ASSISTANCE PROGRAM FOR UP TO \$38,600.00 WITH MATCHING COUNTY FUNDS UP TO \$97,100.00 FROM THE FLORIDA BOATING IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM VESSEL FEES ALLOCATION FUNDS TO RECONSTRUCT A DEMOLISHED FISHING PIER PELICAN HARBOR MARINA AND **FURTHER** AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AND EXPEND FUNDS, AND EXECUTE GRANT AWARD AGREEMENTS, CERTAIN AMENDMENTS AND OTHER DOCUMENTS AS REQUIRED BY FIND AND THE GRANT

WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purpose outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Miami-Dade County is interested in carrying out the following described project for the enjoyment of the citizenry of Miami-Dade County and the State of Florida:

Project Title: Pelican Harbor Marina Fishing Pier - Phase 1

Total Estimated Cost: \$135,700.00

Brief Description of Project: Reconstruct a demolished fishing pier at Pelican Harbor

Marina - Phase 1 (Design & Permitting); and

WHEREAS, Florida Inland Navigation District financial assistance is required for the program mentioned above; and

WHEREAS, as part of its application process, FIND requires that a resolution be adopted by the agency seeking FIND funds in substantially the form of this resolution,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA that this Board authorizes the submittal of a grant application for \$38,600.00 to FIND, Waterways Assistance Program with a County match of \$97,100.00 from the Florida Boating Improvement Program Vessel Fees Allocation Fund,

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said Miami-Dade County shall make application to the Florida Inland Navigation District in the amount of up to 50% of the FIND actual cost in behalf of Miami-Dade County,

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by Miami-Dade County that it certifies to the following:

Section 1. That it will accept the terms and conditions set forth in FIND Rule 66B-2 F.A.C. and which will be a part of the Project Agreement for any assistance awarded under the attached proposal.

Section 2. That it is in complete accord with the proposal for enhancements to Pelican Harbor Marina to reconstruct a demolished fishing pier, that it will carry out the Program in the manner described in the proposal and any plans and specifications attached thereto unless prior approval for any change has been received from the District.

Section 3. That it has the ability and intention to finance its share of the cost of the project and that the project will be operated and maintained at the expense of said Miami Dade-County for public use.

Section 4. That it will not discriminate against any person on the basis of race, color or national origin in the use of any property or facility acquired or developed pursuant to this proposal, and shall comply with the terms and intent of the Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of

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1964, P. L. 88-352 (1964) and design and construct all facilities to comply fully with statutes relating to accessibility by persons with disabilities as well as other federal, state and local laws, rules and requirements.

<u>Section 5</u>. That it will maintain adequate financial records on the proposed project to substantiate claims for reimbursement.

Section 6. That it will make available to FIND if requested, a post-audit of expenses incurred on the project prior to, or in conjunction with, request for the final 10% of the funding agreed to by FIND.

AND, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute grant award agreements, amendments and other documents FIND and the grant require, following approval by the County Attorney's Office as to legal sufficiency; provided however that the County Mayor or Mayor's designee are only delegated the authority to execute amendments that do not have an additional fiscal impact on the County and that otherwise are for projects eligible under the FIND, Waterways Assistance Program. The Board authorizes the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to receive and expend all monies for the purposes described in the funding request for and on behalf of Miami-Dade County, Florida.
