RESOLUTION RENAMING THE REVEREND DR. EDWARD T. GRAHAM NEIGHBORHOOD CENTER LOCATED AT 16405 N.W. 25TH AVENUE, AS THE "REVEREND DR. EDWARD T. GRAHAM COMMUNITY RESOURCE CENTER"

WHEREAS, in honor of the significant contributions Reverend Dr. Edward T. Graham made to Miami-Dade County through his activism and advocacy for racial equality and social justice, on November 19, 2019, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-1199-19, which renamed the Miami Gardens Neighborhood Service Center located at 16405 N.W. 25th Avenue, Miami Gardens as the Reverend Dr. Edward T. Graham Neighborhood Center; and
