Subject: Golden and Patriot Passport Webpage for Renewal or Replacement of damaged  
EASY Cards – Directive No. 191078

On June 4, 2019, the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approved Resolution No. R-618-19, directing the County Mayor to provide a report concerning implementing a plan to provide flexible options for current Golden Passport and Patriot Passport EASY Card holders to renew and replace a lost, stolen, or damaged card. The Resolution also directed a review of the County's Golden Passport and Patriot Passport Program websites be done to provide user-friendly assistance and ensure that information on eligibility and documentation requirements is accurate.

The Golden Passport was created to provide fare-free public transportation services to those residents of Miami-Dade County age 65 and older or those residents who are Social Security beneficiaries. The Patriot Passport Program was created to provide fare-free transportation services to service disabled veterans and those veterans who fall below a certain income threshold. Currently, there are 191,485 Golden Passport (65 and older), 16,977 Golden Passport (Social Security Beneficiary) and 1,457 Patriot Passport active users.

Golden Passport and Patriot Passport cardholders currently have several options available to renew or replace their existing EASY Card Passports.

In addition to current renewal and replacement options, a web-based application has been developed by Miami-Dade County Information Technology Department (ITD) for Golden Passport and Patriot Passport cardholders to renew or replace lost, stolen or damaged EASY Cards, upload required documentation for renewal, make payments for required replacement fees and check the status of a submitted renewal or replacement application. Also, at the June 4, 2019 meeting, the Board approved Resolution R619-19 to reduce replacement costs for lost, stolen or damaged Golden Passport and Patriot Passport Easy Cards. The Golden Passport and Patriot Passport webpage fee schedule, new/renewal application, and replacement form information was updated in June 2019. The income limit for the Patriot Passport changes annually and the website is updated accordingly.
