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Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) authorize the conveyance of an easement which provides electrical service to a portion of County-owned property under the oversight of the Miami-Dade Police Department. More specifically, the resolution does the following:

- Authorizes the conveyance of a 4,667 square foot easement to Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) for a nominal sum of \$1.00 for the construction, operation and maintenance of underground electrical utility facilities, including wires, poles, cables, conduits and related equipment to service the Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute located at 9601 NW 58 Street, Miami, Florida (Folio No.: A Portion of 30-3016-000-0014); and
- Authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute the Underground Easement (Attachment 1), to record the instrument of conveyance in the public records of Miami-Dade County, and to exercise all provisions contained therein.

<u>Scope</u>

The property is located in Commission District 12, which is represented by Commissioner Jose "Pepe" Diaz. Written notice of the easement was provided to the District Commissioner.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

FPL will pay a nominal sum of \$1.00 for the easement and is responsible for the construction, operation and maintenance of the underground electrical utility facilities, including wires, poles, cables conduits and related equipment servicing the building.

Track Record/Monitoring

Idania Barroso of the Internal Services Department is responsible for tasks related to this transaction. Edwin Pantoja of the Miami-Dade Police Department Management Building is responsible for the ongoing operation of the facility.

Delegation of Authority

This item authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute the easement and to exercise all other rights conferred therein.

Background

The conveyance of an easement to FPL is required for the underground power service which is currently being provided to the newly constructed Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute. The facility is a necessary component of Miami-Dade Police Department's effort to graduate Police Officers, Correctional Officers, and FBI Personnel, and to meet the County's public safety and training requirements. The new electrical service originated from overhead service poles along NW 97 Avenue. The 4,667 square foot

easement allows FPL the right to access and provide service to operate the facility. As required by Resolution No. R-504-15, the transformer is mounted on a concrete pad which is screened from view by landscaping in order to minimize any impact to the surrounding area. The easement area will not adversely impact the surrounding area or the operation of the facility.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CONVEYANCE OF A 4,667 SOUARE FOOT EASEMENT TO FLORIDA POWER AND LIGHT COMPANY, FOR A NOMINAL SUM OF \$1.00 TO INSTALL AND MAINTAIN ELECTRICAL UTILITY FACILITIES ON A PORTION OF COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY, LOCATED AT 9601 NW 58 STREET, MIAMI, FLORIDA, KNOWN AS THE MIAMI-DADE PUBLIC SAFETY TRAINING INSTITUTE FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROVIDING ELECTRICAL SERVICE TO SUCH COUNTY-OWNED PROPERTY: AND AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR THE COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE THE UNDERGROUND EASEMENT AND TO EXERCISE ALL **RIGHTS CONFERRED THEREIN**

WHEREAS, on October 6, 2015, the County adopted Resolution No. R-832-15, which directed the County Mayor to add the new Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute Project to the approved project list of Economic Stimulus Projects pursuant to the County's Economic Stimulus Plan; and

WHEREAS, the County, through its Miami-Dade Police Department, constructed the Miami-Dade Public Safety Training Institute (Institute) to serve as Miami-Dade Police Department's training facility; and

WHEREAS, Florida Power and Light Company (FPL) has agreed to provide electric utility facilities to the Institute in exchange for an easement to allow access to install and maintain the facilities; and

WHEREAS, the easement is for electrical service that, in accordance with Resolution No. R-504-15, includes underground lines that does not adversely impact the surrounding area and screens any visible elements from public view; and

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WHEREAS, the Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated into this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. This Board authorizes the conveyance of a 4,667 square foot easement to FPL for a nominal sum of \$1.00, for the installation and maintenance of electric utility facilities to the Institute, and authorizes the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to execute the Underground Easement in substantially the form attached hereto as "Attachment 1" and made part hereof, on behalf of Miami-Dade County and to exercise all provisions set forth therein.

Section 3. Pursuant to Resolution No. R-974-09, this Board (1) directs the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to record the easement in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida, and to provide a recorded copy of the instrument to the Clerk of the Board within 30 days of recordation of the easement, and (2) directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy together with this Resolution.

The foregoing resolution was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

UNDERGROUND EASEMENT

(BUSINESS)

The undersigned, in consideration of the payment of \$1.00 and other good and valuable consideration, the adequacy and receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, grant and give to Florida Power & Light Company, its affiliates, licensees, agents, successors, and assigns ("FPL"), a non-exclusive easement forever for the construction, operation and maintenance of underground electric utility facilities (including cables, conduits, appurtenant equipment, and appurtenant above-ground equipment) to be installed from time to time; with the right to reconstruct, improve, add to, enlarge, change the voltage as well as the size of, and remove such facilities or any of them within an easement described as follows:

Reserved for Circuit Court

See Exhibit "A" ("Easement Area")

Together with the right to permit FPL to attach or place wires to or within any facilities hereunder and lay cable and conduit within the Easement Area and to operate the same for FPL's communications purposes in connection with electric service; the right of ingress and egress to the Easement Area at all times; the right to clear the land and keep it cleared of all trees, undergrowth and other obstructions within the Easement Area; the right to trim and cut and keep trimmed and cut all dead, weak, leaning or dangerous trees or limbs outside of the Easement Area, which might interfere with or fall upon the lines or systems of communications or power transmission or distribution; and further grants, to the fullest extent the undersigned has the power to grant, if at all, the rights hereinabove granted on the Easement Area, over, along, under and across the roads, streets or highways adjoining or through said Easement Area.
