## Recommendation

The following plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This plat for Sunshine Gasoline is bounded on the north by SW 8 Street, on the east approximately 80 feet west of SW 86 Court, on the south approximately 400 feet north of SW 10 Street, and on the west by SW 87 Avenue.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

Full scale copy of the plat and legal description of the boundaries of the land being subdivided, as well as the plat restrictions contained therein, are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

## **Scope**

This plat is located in Commission District 10, which is represented by Senator Javier D. Souto.

### **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

There is no fiscal impact to Miami-Dade County with the approval of this plat as all improvements are in place.



## RESOLUTION NO.

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PLAT OF SUNSHINE GASOLINE FILED BY SUNSHINE GASOLINE DISTRIBUTORS, INC., LOCATED IN THE NORTHWEST 1/4 OF SECTION 10, TOWNSHIP 54 SOUTH, RANGE 40 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH BY SW 8 STREET, ON THE EAST APPROXIMATELY 80 FEET WEST OF SW 86 COURT, ON THE SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 400 FEET NORTH OF SW 10 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY SW 87 AVENUE)

**WHEREAS,** this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Sunshine Gasoline Distributors, Inc., a Florida corporation, has this day presented to this Board a plat of certain lands lying in Miami-Dade County, Florida, said plat to be known as "Sunshine Gasoline," the same being a subdivision of a portion of land lying and being in the Northwest 1/4 of Section 10, Township 54 South, Range 40 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, and it appears that all requirements of law concerning said plat insofar as the authority of this Board is concerned have been complied with,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that said plat is hereby approved; that the dedication of the streets, alleys and other rights-of-way however designated or depicted on said plat is hereby accepted; that the Miami-Dade County Plat Restrictions as listed on said plat are approved and are to be enforced; that approval of the plat is not a waiver of any zoning regulations; and that the requirements of the zoning existing on this land at the time this resolution is approved shall be enforced whether or not the various parcels on this plat conform to those requirements.
