RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING FY 2020-2021 DISTRICT 9 ALLOCATIONS OF FEES COLLECTED FOR ISSUING PARKING PERMITS FOR PERSONS TRANSPORTING YOUNG **CHILDREN** AND **STROLLERS VOICES** FOR **CHILDREN** TO FOUNDATION, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00, HIS HOUSE INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500.00, AND THE ADMIT PROGRAM, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500.00

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-11 provides that one-third of fees collected for issuing parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers shall be distributed to private not-for-profit, non-denominational agencies providing services for severely abused or neglected children on a countywide basis, throughout all of Miami-Dade County, for a countywide purpose; and

WHEREAS, Voices for Children Foundation, Inc., His House, Inc., and the Admit Program, Inc. are private 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, non-denominational entities that serve children countywide and are dedicated to providing services to severely abused or neglected children; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Implementing Order 4-100, each time that one-third of the fees collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers equals \$130,000.00, each Commission district shall be apportioned \$10,000.00 for allocation ("stroller allocation"); and

WHEREAS, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade County to provide funding in the amount of \$5,000.00 to Voices for Children Foundation, Inc., \$2,500.00 to His House, Inc., and \$2,500.00 to the Admit Program, Inc.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated herein in their entirety.

Section 2. This Board hereby approves allocations to Voices for Children Foundation, Inc. in the amount of \$5,000.00, to His House, Inc. in the amount of \$2,500.00, and to the Admit Program, Inc. in the amount of \$2,500.00, and directs the County Mayor or the Mayor's designee to distribute funds collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers as provided herein from the FY 2020-2021 District 9 stroller allocation.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Dennis C. Moss. It was offered by Commissioner , who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
