RESOLUTION DIRECTING COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY
MAYOR’S DESIGNEE TO ORGANIZE A CELEBRATION OF
HEROES ALONG WITH A PRE-OPENING EVENT AT THE
WESTCHESTER HEALTH AND WELLNESS INFORMATION
CENTER ON SEPTEMBER 11, 2021

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-916-04, the voters approved the issuance of general obligation bonds to construct and improve, among other things, healthcare facilities to promote accessibility to quality healthcare services; and

WHEREAS, the Board approved the allocation of funds for the construction of the Westchester Health and Wellness Information Center (“Wellness Center”) to serve the residents of Commission District 10; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center was created by action of this Board, and was spearheaded by Senator Javier D. Souto; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center is currently under construction and has a projected opening of Fall 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center will be a state-of-the-art health, nutrition, exercise, and disease prevention resource for Miami-Dade residents; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center is located adjacent to the Westchester Regional Library and the Francisco Human Rights Park; and

WHEREAS, the Francisco Human Rights Park is a monument to heroes who have dedicated their lives to the cause of human rights; and

WHEREAS, September 11, 2021, will mark the twentieth anniversary of the terrorist attacks against our country on September 11, 2001; and

WHEREAS, the location of the Wellness Center adjacent to the Francisco Human Rights Park makes it an ideal location to hold a celebration of heroes in addition to a pre-opening celebration for the Wellness Center,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor’s designee to organize a celebration of heroes event along with a pre-opening event to be held at the Westchester Health and Wellness Information Center on September 11, 2021.
