WHEREAS, Cheryl E. Johnson, Ed.D was born January 28, 1962, in Sarasota, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson was an integral part of the educational community in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, in 1983, Dr. Johnson graduated from the University of Florida; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson went on to receive her Master of Science and Doctorate of Education from Nova Southeastern University; and

WHEREAS, during her 11 years as an elementary school teacher, Dr. Johnson was twice recognized as a teacher of the year; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson went on to serve as an Assistant Principal at Buena Vista Elementary School, Eneida M. Hartner Elementary School, and Sunset Elementary School; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson served as the beloved principal of G.W. Carver Elementary School for 14 years before her retirement in 2017; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, Dr. Johnson was the Miami-Dade County Parent Teacher Association Principal of the Year runner-up; and

WHEREAS, in 2017, Dr. Johnson received the YMCA Principal Recognition Award; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson was also involved in the community through volunteering at her church and mentoring teachers and new administrators; and

WHEREAS, Grand Avenue runs in front of the G.W. Carver Elementary where Dr. Johnson spent so many years as a dedicated principal; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Johnson passed away on September 30, 2020; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor Dr. Johnson and her contributions to the community by codesignating that portion of Grand Avenue from Lincoln Drive to Jefferson Street "Cheryl E. Johnson Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Grand Avenue from Lincoln Drive to Jefferson Street is a County-maintained road located in the City of Coral Gables; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 7,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, the Board codesignates that portion of Grand Avenue from Lincoln Drive to Jefferson Street "Cheryl E. Johnson Way."

Section 2. The Board urges the City of Coral Gables to join in this codesignation.

Section 3. The Board directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the City Manager and City Commission of the City of Coral Gables, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, the City of Coral Gables Police Department, and the Coral Gables Fire Department.
