RESOLUTION 2020-2021 AUTHORIZING FY DISTRICT 8 ALLOCATIONS OF FEES COLLECTED FOR ISSUING PARKING PERMITS FOR PERSONS TRANSPORTING YOUNG **CHILDREN AND** STROLLERS TO AMIGOS TOGETHER FOR KIDS, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500.00, KRISTI HOUSE, INC. THE **AMOUNT** OF \$2,500.00 IN AND VOICES FOR CHILDREN FOUNDATION, INC. IN THE AMOUNT OF \$2,500.00

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. 13-11 provides that one-third of fees collected for issuing parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers shall be distributed to private not-for-profit, non-denominational agencies providing services for severely abused or neglected children on a countywide basis, throughout all of Miami-Dade County, for a countywide purpose; and

WHEREAS, Amigos Together for Kids, Inc., Kristi House, Inc. and Voices for Children Foundation, Inc. are private 501(c)(3) not-for-profit, non-denominational entities that serve children countywide and are dedicated to providing services to severely abused or neglected children; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Implementing Order 4-100, each time that one-third of the fees collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting young children and strollers equals \$130,000.00, each Commission district shall be apportioned \$10,000.00 for allocation ("stroller allocation"); and

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WHEREAS, the Board believes that it is in the best interest of the citizens of Miami-Dade

County to provide funding in the amount of \$2,500.00 to Amigos Together for Kids, Inc.,

\$2,500.00 to Kristi House, Inc. and \$2,500.00 to Voices for Children Foundation, Inc.,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are approved and incorporated herein in their

entirety.

Section 2. This Board hereby approves allocations to Amigos Together for Kids, Inc.

in the amount of \$2,500.00, Kristi House, Inc. in the amount of \$2,500.00, and to Voices for

Children Foundation, Inc. in the amount of \$2,500.00 and directs the County Mayor or the Mayor's

designee to distribute funds collected from the issuance of parking permits for persons transporting

young children and strollers as provided herein from the FY 2020-2021 District 8 stroller

allocation.
