In accordance with Employee Suggestion Program, A.O. 7-8, employees who submit ideas/suggestions that, based on departmental review do not yield tangible savings are eligible to receive between \$50 and \$1,000, and those whose ideas are deemed to yield tangible savings to the County are awarded 10 percent of the projected annual savings, with a maximum of \$5,000.
