## Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution approving a Maintenance Map, authorizing the Chairperson and the Clerk of the Board to certify same, and authorizing the recordation thereof in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

#### **Scope**

The subject property is located within District 8, which is represented by Commissioner Danielle Cohen Higgins

## **Delegated Authority**

This item delegates authority to the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to record the Maintenance Map in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County and to provide a recorded copy of the instrument to the Clerk of the Board.

#### **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

There is no fiscal impact associated with this resolution. Miami-Dade County already maintains this portion of right of way.

#### Track Record/Monitor

The Department of Transportation and Public Works (DTPW) is the entity overseeing this item and the person responsible is Mr. Leandro Oña, P.E., Chief, Roadway Engineering and Right-of-Way Division

#### **Background**

There are three undedicated properties which extend up to the section/center line of road along the southern portion of SW 184 Street. The northernmost 35 feet of these properties have been utilized as part of SW 184 Street and contain a fully operational traffic lane and other utilities in conjunction with the rest of the improved road. The portions of road have been maintained for more than four years. According to Section 95.361 of the Florida Statutes, the filing of a Maintenance Map in the Office of the Clerk of the Court, which has been certified by the Chairperson and the Clerk of the Board, is deemed prima facie evidence of ownership by the County. The areas depicted by the Maintenance Map attached to the Resolution as Attachment 1 are under the jurisdiction, operation, and maintenance of Miami-Dade County. An affidavit from DTPW's Chief of the Road, Bridge and Canal Maintenance Division certifying the County's historic maintenance of the area is attached as Attachment 2 of the Resolution. It is

RESOLUTION APPROVING A MAINTENANCE MAP FOR A PORTION OF SW 184 STREET IN SECTIONS 4 AND 5, TOWNSHIP 56 SOUTH, RANGE 39 EAST; AUTHORIZING THE CHAIRPERSON AND THE CLERK OF THE BOARD TO CERTIFY THE MAINTENANCE MAP; AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO TAKE ALL ACTIONS NECESSARY TO EFFECTUATE THE SAME

**WHEREAS**, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the Director of the Department of Transportation and Public Works has recommended that an official maintenance map, stating that such road has vested in the County, be filed of record to indicate prima facie evidence of ownership, pursuant to the provisions of Section 95.361 of the Florida Statutes and the County Mayor has concurred with such recommendation,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

**Section 1.** This Board incorporates and adopts the foregoing recitals.

Section 2. This Board approves the Maintenance Map for those portions of SW 184 Street between 210 feet west of SW 157 Avenue and 70 feet west of SW 152 Court, in Sections 4 and 5, Township 56 South, Range 39 East, Miami-Dade County, Florida, as depicted in Attachment 1 to this Resolution. This Board authorizes the Chairperson and the Clerk of the Board to certify the same pursuant to Section 95.361 of the Florida Statutes and authorizes the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to take all actions necessary to effectuate the same.

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Section 3. Pursuant to Resolution No. R-974-09, this Board (a) directs the County Mayor or Mayor's designee to record any instruments executed in connection herewith which create or reserve a property interest in favor of the County, in the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida; and to provide a recorded copy of instruments to the Clerk of the Board within thirty (30) days of execution of said instruments; and (b) directs the Clerk of the Board to attach and permanently store a recorded copy of said instruments together with this resolution.




