RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR THE WESTCHESTER HEALTH AND WELLNESS INFORMATION CENTER

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R-916-04, the voters of Miami-Dade County approved the issuance of general obligation bonds to construct and improve, among other things, healthcare facilities to promote accessibility to quality healthcare services; and

WHEREAS, this Board approved the allocation of funds for the construction of the Westchester Health and Wellness Information Center, located at 9445 Coral Way, Miami, FL 33165 ("Wellness Center"), to serve the residents of Commission District 10; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center was created by action of this Board, and was spearheaded by Senator Javier D. Souto; and

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade Public Library System will manage the Wellness Center which is currently under construction and has a projected opening of early 2022; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center will be a state-of-the-art health, nutrition, exercise, and disease prevention resource for Miami-Dade residents; and

WHEREAS, the Wellness Center is a facility created for the residents of Miami-Dade by this Board; and

WHEREAS, the services provided at the Wellness Center will be provided free of charge; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to urge the Florida legislature to provide funding to build the compilation of educational materials at the Wellness Center, consisting of digital/physical books, serials, databases, and DVDs in English and Spanish, that will provide needed information for the community on health-related topics,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

<u>Section 1.</u> Urges the Florida Legislature to provide funding to build the compilation of educational materials at the Wellness Center, consisting of digital/physical books, serials, databases, and DVDs in English and Spanish, that will provide needed information for the community on health-related topics.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, Senate President, House Speaker, and the Chair and Members of the Miami-Dade State Legislative Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the appropriation set forth in Section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2022 State Legislative Package to include this item.
