### **Recommendation**

The following waiver of plat is submitted for consideration by the Board of County Commissioners (Board) for approval. This waiver of plat for Juan Martinez is bounded on the north approximately 170 feet south of NW 48 Terrace, on the east approximately 120 feet west of NW 31 Avenue, on the south approximately 85 feet north of NW 48 Street, and on the west by NW 31 Court.

The Miami-Dade County Plat Committee recommends approval of this waiver of plat. The Plat Committee is comprised of representatives from:

- Florida Department of Transportation;
- Florida Department of Health;
- Miami-Dade County School Board; and
- Miami-Dade County Departments of Fire Rescue; Parks, Recreation and Open Spaces; Regulatory and Economic Resources; Transportation and Public Works; and Water and Sewer.

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 16-73, this quasi-judicial matter may be submitted directly for placement on the Board's meeting agenda by the Director of the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

A location sketch is attached to this memorandum as Exhibit A.

Legal description of the boundaries of the land are on file with the Department of Regulatory and Economic Resources.

This waiver of plat is located in Commission District 3, which is represented by Commissioner Keon Hardemon.

**RESOLUTION APPROVING THE WAIVER OF PLAT OF JUAN** MARTINEZ, D-24294, FILED BY JUAN MARTINEZ. LOCATED IN THE NORTHEAST 1/4 OF SECTION 21, TOWNSHIP 53 SOUTH, RANGE 41 EAST (BOUNDED ON THE NORTH APPROXIMATELY 170 FEET SOUTH OF NW 48 TERRACE, ON THE EAST APPROXIMATELY 120 FEET AVENUE, WEST OF NW 31 ON THE SOUTH APPROXIMATELY 85 FEET NORTH OF NW 48 STREET, AND ON THE WEST BY NW 31 COURT)
