RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD'S CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF SOUTHWEST 162ND AVENUE BETWEEN SOUTHWEST 328TH STREET AND SOUTHEAST 16TH STREET AS "KATHY DIAZ STREET"

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2021, the City of Homestead (the "City") passed Resolution No. R2021-12-159, which codesignated that portion of Southwest 162nd Avenue between Southwest 328th Street and Southeast 16th Street as "Kathy Diaz Street"; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the City Resolution No. R2021-12-159 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, Kathiria "Kathy" Diaz ("Ms. Diaz") was born on February 7, 1982, in New York City, New York; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Diaz later became a resident of the City and was a founding staff member of the Gateway Environmental K-8 Learning Center ("Gateway K-8") located in the City; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Diaz served the Gateway K-8 for 11 years; and

WHEREAS, Ms. Diaz passed away from pancreatic cancer on September 24, 2020, at the age of 38, leaving behind her son Jeremy; and

WHEREAS, Southwest 162nd Avenue from Southwest 328th Street to Southeast 16th Street is a City-maintained road located in the City of Homestead; and

WHEREAS, the City would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 9; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Ms. Diaz by approving the City of Homestead’s codesignation of that portion of Southwest 162nd Avenue between Southwest 328th Street and Southeast 16th Street as “Kathy Diaz Street”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Homestead’s codesignation of that portion of Southwest 162nd Avenue between Southwest 328th Street and Southeast 16th Street as “Kathy Diaz Street”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Homestead, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the City of Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, and the City of Homestead Police Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Kionne L. McGhee. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:



RESOLUTION NO. R2021-12-159

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, APPROVING AND RENAMING OR CO-DESIGNATING A PORTION OF SW 162ND AVENUE, FROM SW 328TH STREET TO SE 16TH STREET, AS “KATHY DIAZ STREET”; PROVIDING FOR IMPLEMENTATION; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, with the rapid growth of the City of Homestead (the “City”), it has become eminently important to preserve the City’s history and to provide recognition to those individuals that have helped to shape the Homestead community; and

WHEREAS, the City has adopted guidelines and processes by which residents can honor individuals who have made extraordinary contributions to the community; and

WHEREAS, in recognition of her contributions to the City, the Council recommends that a portion of SW 162nd Avenue, from SW 328th Street to SE 16th Street, be designated as “Kathy Diaz Street;” and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interests of its residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HOMESTEAD, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. Recitals Adopted. Each of the above stated recitals is hereby adopted and confirmed.


Section 3. Implementation. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to take any and all actions necessary to implement the Procedures and purposes of this Resolution.
