### **Executive Summary**

The attached resolution seeks ratification of a Non-Exclusive Professional Service Agreement with Blascom Engineering, Inc. (Agreement No. 21BEI001) in an amount not to exceed \$2,200,000.00 for engineering services related to the improvement, upgrades and expansions of Water and Wastewater Treatment Plants, Pump Stations, Collection, Distribution and Transmission Piping, and all related facilities as necessary to ensure quality control/assurance for Water and Sewer Department's Capital Improvement Projects, Project No. E20-WASD-02A.

### Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) ratifies the action of the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee, as authorized under Section 2-8.2.12 of the Miami-Dade County Code related to Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department's Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance (WASD Acceleration Ordinance) for the funded project identified below and in Exhibit A, as attached.

### **Multi-Year Capital Plan Projects**

Miami-Dade County intends to retain a qualified firm for a Professional Service Agreement (PSA) to provide geotechnical services, special inspections, structural assessments, soils, foundations and material testing services related to the improvement, upgrades and expansions of water and wastewater treatment plants, pump stations, collection, distribution and transmission piping, and all related facilities as necessary to ensure quality control/assurance for Water and Sewer Department's Capital Improvement.

<u>Item 1</u> – Recommendation Approving Award of a Non-Exclusive Professional Services Agreement for Geotechnical Services, Special Inspections, Structural Assessments, Soils, Foundations and Material Testing Services Related to the Improvement, Upgrades and Expansions of Water and Wastewater Treatment Plants, Pump Stations, Collection, Distribution and Transmission Piping, and All Related Facilities as Necessary to Ensure Quality Control/Assurance for Water and Sewer Department's Capital Improvement Projects, Project No. E20-WASD-02A Agreement No. 21BEI001. \$2,200,000.00, with a total contract term of five years to Blascom Engineering, Inc. The PSA was fully executed and attested by the Clerk Office on March 3, 2022.

### **Delegation of Authority**

This contract was awarded pursuant to Section 2-8.2.12 of the Miami-Dade County Code related to WASD's Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance, which delegates authority to the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to award certain projects, and among other things, negotiate, and settle claims, and execute change orders that do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the base contract amount, all subject to ratification by the Board.

### **Scope**

In an effort to continue providing good quality and reliable drinking water and sanitary services, the County needs to upgrade and rehabilitate its water and sewer assets located throughout the County. The services to be provided under this PSA are soils, foundations, geotechnical and materials testing services plus special structural integrity assessments, threshold building inspections, and other special inspections as necessary for the new facilities, refurbishments, design and construction of all projects included in the Capital Improvement Program schedule. This project is awarded through WASD's Acceleration Ordinance and has a countywide impact.

### **Fiscal Impact/Funding Source**

The funding sources for this project are as follows: BCC GOB Financing, Future WASD Revenue Bonds, WASD Revenue Bonds Sold, Future Subordinate Debt, State Revolving Loan Wastewater Program, WASD Revenue Bonds Sold, WIFIA Loan, Wastewater Connection Charges, Wastewater Renewal Fund, Wastewater Special Construction Fund, Water Renewal and Replacement Fund, Water Connection Charges, Fire Hydrant Fund and are also detailed on Exhibit A and other accompanying attachments. The fiscal impact to the County will be \$2,200,000.00 for this project.

### **Track Record/Monitoring**

WASD's Deputy Director, Marisela Aranguiz of Capital Improvements, will oversee the implementation of these projects.

### **Due Diligence/Safety Information**

Due diligence was conducted by WASD and the Internal Services Department (ISD) in accordance with ISD's Procurement Guidelines to determine responsibility, including verifying corporate status; performance; safety record, including Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA) records; and compliance data. The lists that were reviewed include: convicted vendors, debarred vendors, delinquent contractors, suspended vendors, and federally excluded parties. There were no adverse findings related to the Contractor's responsibility. This information is being provided pursuant to Resolution No. R-187-12.

### **Background**

On September 3, 2014, the Board approved Ordinance No. 14-77 authorizing the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to award contracts for funded capital projects and related goods and services, and to accelerate the approval of WASD's (1) Consent Decree projects and (2) projects

identified in WASD Multi-Year Capital Plan's Capital Improvements Program without the need for prior Board approval but subject to ratification by the Board.

RECOMMENDATION:

Pursuant to the Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) Consent Decree and Capital Improvement Programs Acceleration Ordinance Section 2-8.2.12 of the Miami-Dade County Code, it is recommended that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee approve the attached Non-Exclusive Professional Services Agreement with Blascom Engineering, Inc. (Blascom) to provide geotechnical services, special inspections, structural assessments, soils, foundations and material testing services related to the improvement, upgrades and expansions of water and wastewater treatment plants, pump stations, collection, distribution and transmission piping, and all related facilities as necessary to ensure quality control/assurance for Water and Sewer Department's Capital Improvement Projects; Project No. E20-WASD-02A; Contract No. 21BEI001 (the Contract). The total compensation amount shall not exceed \$2,200,000, which includes a ten percent (10%) contingency allowance and a contract term of five (5) years.

### **DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY:**

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-8.2.12 of the Miami-Dade County Code, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee has the authority to execute, amend and terminate the Contract and to resolve disputes. Additionally, pursuant to the provisions of Sections 2-8.2.12 (4)(d) and (e) of the Code, the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee has the authority to amend and/or extend the Agreement to complete any unfinished work, waive liquidated damages, negotiate and settle claims, and execute change orders that do not exceed ten percent (10%) of the base/alternate contract amount. Pursuant to Section 2-8.2.12 (7), all actions taken pursuant to Section 2-8.2.12 are subject to ratification by the Board of County Commissioners.

On April 16, 2021, SBD completed its review of the SBE contract measures and confirmed that all participant firms were in compliance with the submittal requirements. See attached Exhibit "E", "SBD Compliance Review".

FIRST TIER MEETING: At the First Tier "Evaluation of Qualifications" meeting held on August 5, 2021, the Competitive Selection Committee (CSC) reviewed and ranked the firms in accordance with the evaluation criteria outlined in the solicitation. The CSC elected by majority vote to forego Second Tier proceedings and recommended that the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee approve negotiations with Blascom. See attached Exhibit "F", "First Tier Tabulation Report".

The Prime Consultant shall also describe the firm's Quality Control and Assurance procedures pertaining to field sample collection, laboratory testing, transmission and storage of data, document management, etc. Consultant may also describe any specific software/application that is used to collect, store, manage and report on data from the work conducted in the field under this contract and method of communications and reporting of such data to all project stakeholders for any project.

The Prime consultant should provide descriptions of at least two (2) successfully completed projects where similar services of each listed technical categories were provided prior to the date of this solicitation. ### SMALL BUSINESS ENTERPRISE - ARCHITECTURAL & ENGINEERING (SBE-A&E)

An analysis of the factors contained in the project package, as well as the factors contained in Section V.B. of Implementing Order 3-32 and the responses of certified SBE/AE firms to the Verification of Availability to Propose process indicates a 100% SBE-A&E Set Aside is appropriate for this contract. Verification of Availability to Propose letters were sent to the SBE-A&E firms certified in the technical categories below and three (3) or more firms certified in TC's 9.01, 9.02 & 9.03 responded as being able to satisfy the prime minimum requirements.
