AVENUE AS "WATERFORD DISTRICT DRIVE"

WHEREAS, the Waterford Business District spans 250 acres in unincorporated Miami-Dade County, south of Miami International Airport; and

EASTERN TERMINUS AT THEORETICAL NW 52ND

WHEREAS, the Waterford Business District has been a professional hub in Miami-Dade County for over 30 years; and

WHEREAS, the Waterford Business District is currently a hub for over 100 companies, including numerous multinational and Fortune 500 companies; and

WHEREAS, the Waterford Business District has one of the highest concentrations of regional and Latin American business headquarters in South Florida; and

WHEREAS, the Waterford Business District is a significant business district that serves Miami-Dade County residents, professionals, business visitors, and businesses, and provides significant economic benefit and activity to the community; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to honor and recognize the significance of the Waterford Business District by codesignating Blue Lagoon Drive from NW 65th Avenue to its eastern terminus at theoretical NW 52nd Avenue as "Waterford District Drive"; and

WHEREAS, Blue Lagoon Drive from NW 65th Avenue to NW 52nd Avenue is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of Blue Lagoon Drive from NW 65th Avenue to its eastern terminus at theoretical NW 52nd Avenue as "Waterford District Drive".

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade County Police Department, and Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue.
