RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI'S CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF SOUTHWEST 62ND PLACE FROM SOUTHWEST 62ND TERRACE TO SOUTHWEST 63RD TERRACE AS "JOANN JEFFERY MCCANTS WAY"

WHEREAS, the City of South Miami passed Resolution No. 043-22-15796 on April 19, 2022, which codesignated that portion of Southwest 62nd Place from Southwest 62nd Terrace to Southwest 63rd Terrace as "JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way"; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. 043-22-15796 is attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn Jeffery McCants was a longtime member of the South Miami community; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn was the daughter of Fred and Doris Horton and the oldest of 13 siblings; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn was the founding Pastor at the New Life Community Outreach Ministries, where she served her faith community for 14 years; and

WHEREAS, Pastor JoAnn was very passionate about giving, outreach was very important to her, and sharing her faith was her mission; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn retired in 2021 as a records supervisor after serving 30 years with the Florida City Police Department, where she also served as Chaplain; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn Jeffery McCants passed away on February 18, 2022; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn was highly esteemed in the South Miami community; and

WHEREAS, the City of South Miami would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal masts arms; and

WHEREAS, Southwest 62nd Place from Southwest 62nd Terrace to Southwest 63rd Terrace is a city-maintained road located in the City of South Miami; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 7; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor JoAnn Jeffery McCants by approving the City of South Miami’s codesignation of that portion of Southwest 62nd Place from Southwest 62nd Terrace to Southwest 63rd Terrace as “JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of South Miami’s codesignation of that portion of Southwest 62nd Place from Southwest 62nd Terrace to Southwest 63rd Terrace as “JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of South Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue, and the City of South Miami Police Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Raquel A. Regalado. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 043-22-15796

A Resolution of the Mayor and City Commission of the City of South Miami, amending Resolution 032-22-15785 and co-designating SW 62nd Place, from SW 62nd Terrace to SW 63rd Terrace as “JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way”.

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2022, the City adopted Resolution No. 032-22-15785 that named SW 62" Place, from SW 62" Terrace to SW 63rd Terrace as "James and JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way"; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn McCants was a longtime member of the South Miami community; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn was the daughter of Fred and Doris Horton and the oldest of 13 siblings; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn was the founding Pastor at the New Life Community Outreach Ministries where she put the actions of her heart to work by serving the church for 14 years; and

WHEREAS, Pastor JoAnn was very passionate about giving and outreach was very important to her and spreading the word of God was her mission; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn retired in 2021 as a records supervisor after serving 30 years with the Florida City Police Department. During her time there, she also served as Chaplain; and

WHEREAS, JoAnn was much loved in the South Miami community; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and Commission of the City of South Miami to amend Resolution No. 032-22-15785 by removing the phrase "James and" from the street name and to name SW 62nd Place, from SW 62nd Terrace to SW 63rd Terrace as “JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way”.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF SOUTH MIAMI, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing recitals are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and they are incorporated into this resolution by reference as if set forth in full herein.

Section 2: The City Commission wishes amend Resolution No. 032-22-15785 so as to co-designate SW 62nd Place, from SW 62nd Terrace to SW 63rd Terrace, as “JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way” and that it will, as soon as authorized by Miami Dade County, be known in and by the City of South Miami as “JoAnn Jeffery McCants Way”, and signs shall be made and installed declaring that designation.

Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to submit this Resolution to Miami-Dade County (County) and to take all other necessary actions to carry out the purpose of this Resolution,

including providing a copy of it to the US Postal Service and to the appropriate agencies after it has been approved by the County.

Section 4: Corrections. Conforming language or technical scrivener-type corrections may be made by the City Attorney for any conforming amendments to be incorporated into the final resolution for signature.

Section 5: Severability. If any section clause, sentence, or phrase of this resolution is for any reason held invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, the holding will not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this resolution.


Section 6: Effective Date. This resolution will become effective immediately upon adoption by vote of the City Commission.


