RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS’
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF SWAN AVENUE
BETWEEN ALBATROSS STREET AND CARDINAL STREET
AS “JAKE CASIANO DRIVE”

WHEREAS, on January 24, 2022, the City of Miami Springs Council passed Resolution No. R-2022-3971, which codesignated that portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Steet as “Jake Casiano Drive”; and

WHEREAS, a copy of Resolution No. R-2022-3971 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Jake William Casiano (“Jake”) was a City of Miami Springs resident born on December 10, 2009, to Cindy and Christopher Casiano, one of three boys; and

WHEREAS, Jake was known to fill any room he was in with laughter, and has been described as intelligent, joyous, happy, kind, and compassionate; and

WHEREAS, Jake was diagnosed with leukemia in June 2018 and, after a courageous three-year battle with the disease, passed away on May 8, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Springs would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Jake by approving the City of Miami Springs’ codesignation of that portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Steet as “Jake Casiano Drive”; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Steet is a city-maintained road located in the City of Miami Springs; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 6,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami Springs’ codesignation of that portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Steet as “Jake Casiano Drive”.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit certified copies of this Resolution to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Miami Springs, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, and the City of Miami Springs Police Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Rebeca Sosa. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:

RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 3971

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA, CO-DESIGNATING A PORTION OF SWAN AVENUE BETWEEN ALBATROSS STREET AND CARDINAL STREET AS “JAKE CASIANO DRIVE”; PROVIDING FOR AUTHORIZATION; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Springs (the “City”) Council hereby seeks to recognize and honor Jake William Casiano (“Jake”); and

WHEREAS, Jake was a City resident, born December 10, 2009 to Cindy and Christopher Casiano, one of three boys; and

WHEREAS, Jake was described as intelligent, joyous, happy, kind and compassionate, filling any room with laughter; and

WHEREAS, in June 2018, Jake was diagnosed with leukemia and, after a courageous three-year battle with the disease, on May 8, 2021, Jake succumbed to his diagnosis; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that it is proper and appropriate to recognize and memorialize Jake Casiano by designating the portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Street as “Jake Casiano Drive”; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that this Resolution is in the best interest and welfare of the residents of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI SPRINGS, FLORIDA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Recitals. That the above recitals are confirmed, adopted, and incorporated herein and made a part hereof by reference.

Section 2. Co-Designation. The City Council hereby approves the co-designation of the portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Street as “Jake Casiano Drive” as shown on Exhibit “A” attached hereto.

Section 3. Authorization. The City Council authorizes the City Manager to take all actions necessary to implement this Resolution. The City Manager is authorized to place the appropriate signage or markers along the designated area.

Section 4. Effective Date. That this Resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
