SUBJECT: Resolution approving the City of Miami Springs' codesignation of that portion of Swan Avenue between Albatross Street and Cardinal Street as "Jake Casiano Drive"

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(f) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of naming, renaming, or codesignation item or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background check on "Jake Casiano" and noted no adverse findings. OCA determined that there is no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignation for "Jake Casiano." As also required by Rule 9.02(f)(1), OCA verified that "Jake Casiano" is deceased.
