The code further provides that nomination for the at-large appointments shall be submitted to the Chair of the Board of County Commissioners to be voted on by the Board.

Mr. Steven (Max) Losner has expressed an interest in serving on the PAB. Chairman Jose "Pepe" Diaz is presenting him as a qualified nominee to fill one of the vacant at-large seats.
