	RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING	G THE SOUTHWEST 152ND

WHEREAS, Kareem Angel Green ("Kareem") was born in May 2001; and

ANGEL GREEN STREET"

WHEREAS, on June 16, 2006, while on a school trip, Kareem lost his life to drowning at the precious age of five; and

BLOCK OF SOUTHWEST 308TH STREET AS "KAREEM

WHEREAS, to keep Kareem's memory alive and to help to prevent similar water-related tragedies, Kareem's mother, Ms. Arkeisha Reese ("Reese"), created the Team Kareem Memorial Foundation, a nonprofit foundation to educate children and adults on the importance of being safe around water; and

WHEREAS, in Kareem's memory, Ms. Reese developed a program that provides free swimming lessons and related services to children and families; and

WHEREAS, according to data published by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (the "CDC"), each year there are approximately 4,000 fatal drownings in the United States – an average of 11 drowning deaths per day; and

WHEREAS, according to the CDC, more children ages 1–4 die from drowning than any other cause of death except birth defects, and for children ages 1–14, drowning is the second leading cause of unintentional injury death after motor vehicle crashes; and

WHEREAS, in light of these troubling statistics, this Board recognizes the work Ms.

Reese continues to do in Kareem's honor and wishes to name the Southwest 152nd Block of Southwest 308th Street as "Kareem Angel Green Street"; and

WHEREAS, the Southwest 152nd Block of Southwest 308th Street is a County-maintained road located in unincorporated Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 8,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

<u>Section 1</u>. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates the Southwest 152nd Block of Southwest 308th Street as "Kareem Angel Green Street."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Danielle Cohen Higgins.
