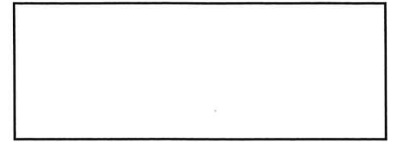

SUBJECT: Resolution approving the City of Miami codesignation of Southwest 29th Avenue from West Flagler Street to Southwest 4th Street as “Eddy Calderón Street”

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(f) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of naming, renaming, or codesignation item or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor’s Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background check on “Eddy Calderón” and noted no adverse findings. The Board of County Commissioners (BCC) adopted Resolution No. R-380-22 which approved the City of Miami’s codesignation of Southwest 2nd Street from Southwest 27th Avenue to Southwest 30th Avenue as “Eddy Calderón Street.” After the action taken by the BCC, the City of Miami rescinded its earlier codesignation and approved a new codesignation bearing Calderón’s name along Southwest 29th Avenue from West Flagler Street to Southwest 4th Street. As also required by Rule 9.02(f)(1), OCA verified that “Eddy Calderón” is deceased. OCA provides this report as a Supplement to BCC Agenda File Item No. 221849.
