RESOLUTION AMENDING FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023 ADOPTED COUNTY BUDGET TO ALLOCATE ADDITIONAL \$225,000.00 TO CATHOLIC LEGAL SERVICES OF THE ARCHDIOCESE OF MIAMI, INC. FOR THE PROVISION OF IMMIGRATION SERVICES TO BE FUNDED FROM THE MIAMI RESCUE PLAN'S FUTURE SEPTIC TO SEWER/INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT PROGRAMS FUND

WHEREAS, the fiscal year 2022-2023 adopted County budget includes a \$1,000,000.00 allocation from the Miami Rescue Plan to Catholic Legal Services of the Archdiocese of Miami, Inc. ("CLS") for the provision of immigration services; and

WHEREAS, CLS is a nationally recognized agency with an experienced team of attorneys and immigration professionals whose mission it is to provide professional legal services to those who come from foreign lands who lack sufficient means to obtain representation without regard to faith, national origin or any other distinguishing characteristic; and

WHEREAS, CLS focuses exclusively on helping poor immigrants obtain asylum, establish legal residency, become citizens, reunite families and understand immigration law and policies by providing public education; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to amend the fiscal year 2022-2023 adopted County budget to allocate an additional \$225,000.00 from the Miami Rescue Plan's Future Septic to Sewer/Infrastructure Project Programs fund for the provision of immigration services,

## NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

<u>Section 1.</u> Approves the foregoing recitals and incorporates them herein by reference.

## MDC003

Amends the fiscal year 2022-2023 adopted County budget to allocate an Section 2. additional \$225,000.00 to CLS from the Miami Rescue Plan's Future Septic to Sewer/Infrastructure Project Programs fund for the provision of immigration services. Following this amendment, the balance in the Miami Rescue Plan's Future Septic to Sewer/Infrastructure Project Programs fund shall be reduced from \$50,225,000.00 to \$50,000,000.00.
