WHEREAS, on May 24, 2023, the Mayor and City Council of the City of Miami Gardens adopted Resolution No. 2023-062-1952, which codesignated the portion of Northwest ("NW") 12th Avenue between NW 191st and NW 199th Street in the City of Miami Gardens as "Vikings Avenue," in honor of Miami Norland Senior High School; and

12TH AVENUE BETWEEN NORTHWEST 191ST AND

NORTHWEST 199TH STREET AS "VIKINGS AVENUE"

**WHEREAS**, a copy of Resolution No. 2023-062-1952 is attached hereto and incorporated by reference; and

WHEREAS, Miami Norland Senior High School, whose mascot is a Viking, opened its doors to students in 1958; and

WHEREAS, the school's mission is "to provide a quality experience that will educate students to fulfill their roles as responsible, productive citizens who respect individuality, cultural differences, and realize their potential as life-long learners"; and

WHEREAS, under the current leadership of Principal Rhonda Gaines-Miller, Miami Norland Senior High School now offers Academies (Magnet Programs) in Biotechnology and Forensics, Hospitality and Tourism, Informational Technology, Visual & Performing Arts, and Sports Medicine; and

WHEREAS, Miami Norland Senior High School also provides a rigorous and challenging curriculum through the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE), which is a four-year course of study designed to prepare graduates to enter the nation's leading universities; and

WHEREAS, this Board would also like to honor Miami Norland Senior High School and the school's contributions to the community by approving the City of Miami Gardens codesignation of that portion of NW 12th Avenue between NW 191st and NW 199th Street as "Vikings Avenue"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 12th Avenue between NW 191st and NW 199th Street is a city-maintained street located in the City of Miami Gardens; and

WHEREAS, the City of Miami Gardens would like the County to install signage indicating this codesignation on County street signs and traffic signal mast arms; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 1,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Approves the City of Miami Gardens codesignation of that portion of NW 12th Avenue between NW 191st and NW 199th Street as "Vikings Avenue."

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Mayor and City Council of the City of Miami Gardens, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resource Department, the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department, and the City of Miami Gardens Police Department.

## RESOLUTION NO. 2023-062-1952

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE RENAMING OF NW 12TH AVENUE NORTH FROM 191ST STREET TO 199TH STREET AS "VIKINGS AVENUE"; AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO CHANGE THE STREET SIGNAGE; PROVIDING FOR THE ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Councilman Robert Stephens, III, wishes to rename NW 12th Avenue from 191st Street to 199th Street to "Vikings Avenue" in recognition of Miami Norland Senior High School, and

WHEREAS, that portion of NW 12th Avenue is a City Street, and

WHEREAS, Section 34-233 of the City of Miami Gardens Code of Ordinance outlines the process for renaming and codesignating streets, and

WHEREAS, Section 44-233 (b)(10) provides the Mayor and members of the City Council may sponsor a Resolution for the renaming or codesignation of a street, and

WHEREAS, Miami Norland Senior High School opened its doors to students in 1958, and

WHEREAS, Miami Norland Senior High School mission is to provide a quality experience that will educate students to fulfill their roles as responsible, productive citizens who respect individuality, cultural differences, and realize their potential as lifelong learners, and

WHEREAS, under the current leadership of Principal Ms. Rhonda Gaines-Miller, Norland High School now offers Academies (Magnet Programs) in Biotechnology and Forensics, Hospitality and Tourism, Informational Technology, Visual & Performing Arts, and Sports Medicine, and

WHEREAS, Norland High School provides a rigorous and challenging curriculum through the Cambridge Advanced International Certificate of Education (AICE), which is a four-year course of study that has proven results in preparing graduates to enter the nation's leading universities, and

WHEREAS, Councilman Stephens is recommending the City Council approve the attached Resolution renaming NW 12th Avenue from 191st Street to 199th Street as 'Vikings Avenue' and directing the City Manager to take all steps necessary to change the street signage on NW 12th Avenue for this purpose, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MIAMI GARDENS, FLORIDA AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1: ADOPTION OF REPRESENTATIONS: The foregoing Whereas paragraphs are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true, and the same are hereby made a specific part of this Resolution.

Section 2: AUTHORIZATION: The City Council of the City of Miami Gardens hereby authorizes the renaming of NW 12th Avenue from 191st Street to 199th Street as 'Vikings Avenue'. The City Council further authorizes the City Manager to change the street signage.

Section 3: EFFECTIVE DATE: This Resolution shall take effect immediately upon its final passage.
