RESOLUTION WAIVING BY A TWO-THIRDS VOTE OF MEMBERS PRESENT TERM LIMIT RESTRICTION FOR COUNTY BOARD MEMBERS; AND REAPPOINTING RICARDO GONZALEZ TO THE FIRE PREVENTION AND SAFETY APPEALS BOARD

WHEREAS, on January 21, 2010, the Board of County Commissioners enacted Ordinance No. 10-06, amending Chapter 2, Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida to permit the waiver of term limits for members of County boards; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Section 2-11.38.2 of the Code, no board member shall serve more than eight (8) consecutive years on a board unless the Board of County Commissioners, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, votes to waive the eight (8) year term limit; and

WHEREAS, according to Section 14-46(B) of the Code, members on the Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals Board serve for three (3) year terms; and

WHEREAS, Ricardo Gonzalez has served on the Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals

Board for more than eight (8) years; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to waive the applicable term limit and reappoint Ricardo Gonzalez to the Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals Board for another three (3) year term; and WHEREAS, a copy of Ricardo Gonzalez's resumé is attached,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board, by a two-thirds vote of the members present, waives the restriction that a particular member of a board

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may not serve more than eight (8) consecutive years on that board, and reappoints Ricardo Gonzalez to an additional three (3) year term as a member of the Fire Prevention and Safety Appeals Board.
