|            | RESOLUTION SUPPORTING ISRAEL AND CONDEMNING THE UNPROVOKED AND UNJUSTIFIED WAR LAUNCHED |                           |  |  |  |

BY HAMAS TERRORISTS AGAINST ISRAEL

WHEREAS, early Saturday morning, October 7, 2023, Hamas terrorists, the militant group that controls Gaza, launched an unprovoked and unjustified war on Israel by air, land, and sea, including launching thousands of missiles; and

WHEREAS, the United States Department of State and European Union have designated Hamas a terrorist organization because of its armed resistance against Israel, which has included suicide bombings and rocket attacks; and

WHEREAS, the large-scale surprise attack by Hamas represents the most dangerous escalation in the Israeli–Palestinian conflict in decades and comes almost exactly 50 years after the Yom Kippur War against Israel in 1973, when Israel was similarly taken by surprise in a sudden attack by neighboring Egypt and Syria; and

WHEREAS, on October 7, 2023, Hamas terrorists sent gunman through the security barrier into southern Israel, slaughtering innocent civilians and abducting many of them as hostages, including women, children, and the elderly, according to Israeli Defense Forces; and

WHEREAS, Hamas terrorists also launched thousands of missiles into southern and central Israel; and

**WHEREAS**, according to Israeli Defense Forces, more than 900 people were killed and over 2,500 injured in Israel from Hamas' massive surprise assault, including innocent women, children, and the elderly; and

WHEREAS, eleven American citizens in Israel are among those killed by Hamas terrorists, confirmed by officials from the U.S. State Department and the National Security Council; and

WHEREAS, there are still a number of unaccounted-for Americans that the State

Department is working with its Israeli partners to help locate; and

**WHEREAS**, early Sunday, October 8, 2023, Israeli forces were still fighting to regain control of eight areas of the country's territory from Hamas terrorists; and

WHEREAS, the death tolls are expected to rise significantly as Israel formally declared war on Hamas on October 8, 2023, and Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu predicted a "long and difficult war"; and

WHEREAS, the acts of terrorism committed by Hamas against Israel threatens global peace and security; and

WHEREAS, this Board supports Israel as it protects its citizens from the heinous crimes committed by Hamas terrorists; and

WHEREAS, this Board supports Israel as it defends itself against the barbaric war launched by Hamas; and

WHEREAS, this Board condemns Hamas' brutal war on Israel,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Supports Israel and condemns the unprovoked and unjustified war launched by Hamas terrorists against Israel.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the President of the United States and the members of the Florida Congressional Delegation.
