RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF THE RICKENBACKER CAUSEWAY FROM ARTHUR LAMB JR. ROAD TO VIRGINIA BEACH DRIVE AS "TOKITAE WAY"

**WHEREAS**, Tokitae, also known as Lolita or Toki, was an orca who entertained guests for more than 50 years at the Miami Seaquarium; and

**WHEREAS**, Tokitae was the name given to the orca by indigenous people in Washington state, who advocated for her to return to her native waters of Washington; and

**WHEREAS**, according to the Miami Herald, Tokitae passed away on August 25, 2023, from old age and multiple chronic illnesses; and

WHEREAS, at the time of her death, Tokitae was being trained for a possible crosscountry move to her native waters in the Pacific Northwest; and

WHEREAS, Tokitae was beloved by generations of Miami-Dade County residents and visitors alike; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to memorialize Tokitae by codesignating a section of the Rickenbacker Causeway, from Arthur Lamb Jr. Road to Virginia Beach Drive as "Tokitae Way"; and

WHEREAS, that portion of the Rickenbacker Causeway, from Arthur Lamb Jr. Road to Virginia Beach Drive is a County-maintained road located the City of Miami; and

WHEREAS, this proposed codesignation is located in County Commission District 7,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing codesignates that portion of the Rickenbacker Causeway, from Arthur Lamb Jr. Road to Virginia Beach Drive as "Tokitae Way".

**Section 2.** Urges the City of Miami to join in this codesignation.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Mayor and Commission of the City of Miami, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Miami-Dade Police Department, and the Miami-Dade Fire Rescue Department.
