RESOLUTION URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDING FOR PHASE I PARK FLOOD MITIGATION AND INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS AT THE FORMER MELREESE GOLF COURSE IN MIAMI-DADE COUNTY

WHEREAS, Senator Bryan Avila (R – Hialeah Gardens) and Representative Lawrence McClure (R – Plant City) have submitted appropriations requests for consideration during the 2024 session of the Florida Legislature requesting \$5,000,000.00 for Fiscal Year 2024-2025 for Phase I park flood mitigation and infrastructure improvements at the site formerly known as the Melreese Golf Course in Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, Phase I is central to a wider environmental remediation and conversion of the former golf course with contaminated soil into a community asset, fostering recreation alongside a separately funded economic development and global innovation initiative; and

WHEREAS, Phase I of the project includes golf course conversion and remediation efforts, solid pipe drainage, catch basins, water and sewer systems, bike paths, sidewalks, a wellness loop, tree planting, landscaping, electrical work, and other amenities; and

WHEREAS, Phase I enhancements are necessary to develop the site and drive economic growth in our community; and

WHEREAS, this Board is supportive of this development, and accordingly, wishes to urge the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding for same,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Urges the Florida Legislature to appropriate funding for Phase I park flood mitigation and infrastructure improvements at the former Melreese Golf Course in Miami-Dade County.

Section 2. Directs the Clerk of the Board to transmit a certified copy of this resolution to the Governor, the Senate President, the House Speaker, Senator Bryan Avila, Representative Lawrence McClure, and the Chair and remaining Members of the Miami-Dade County State Legislative Delegation.

Section 3. Directs the County's state lobbyists to advocate for the action set forth in section 1 above, and authorizes and directs the Office of Intergovernmental Affairs to amend the 2024 State Legislative Package to include this item.
