RESOLUTION DESIGNATING RASHA CAMEAU AS
CHAIRWOMAN AND JEFFY V. MONDESIR AS VICE
CHAIRMAN OF THE N.W. 7TH AVENUE CORRIDOR
COMMUNITY REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY IN
ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION 163.356, FLORIDA
STATUTES, AND SECTION 2-1889 OF THE CODE OF MIAMI-
DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA

WHEREAS, this Board created the NW 7th Avenue Corridor Community Redevelopment Agency (“Agency”) upon the adoption of Ordinance No. 06-18 and appointed an initial Agency board of commissioners pursuant to section 163.356, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, on September 4, 2024, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-783-24, which appointed Rasha Cameau as a commissioner to the Agency; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to section 163.356 and section 2-1889 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida (the “Code”), this Board, as the governing body of the Agency, has the authority to designate the chair and vice chair of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to designate Rasha Cameau as chairwoman of the Agency in accordance with section 163.356, Florida Statutes, and section 2-1889 of the Code; and

WHEREAS, on November 15, 2022, this Board adopted Resolution No. R-1134-22, which, among other things, appointed Jeffy V. Mondesir as a commissioner and designated him as vice chairman of the Agency; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to designate Jeffy V. Mondesir again as vice chairman of the Agency, in accordance with section 163.356, Florida Statutes, and section 2-1889 of the Code,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The foregoing recitals are incorporated in this resolution and are approved.

Section 2. This Board, in accordance with section 163.356, Florida Statutes, and section 2-1889 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, Florida, designates Rasha Cameau as chairwoman and Jeffy V. Mondesir as vice chairman of the NW 7th Avenue Corridor Community Redevelopment Agency.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Commissioner Marleine Bastien. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
