Subject: FY 2025 SHIP Homebuyer Education and Counseling Award Recommendations

Executive Summary

This item recommends the approval for the Fiscal Year (FY) 2025 State Housing Initiatives Partnership (SHIP) Homebuyer Education and Counseling Request for Applications (RFA). It is recommended that six (6) entities be awarded funding to provide homebuyer education and counseling services throughout the northern, central, and southern geographic areas of Miami-Dade County.

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board):

- Approve the proposed funding recommendations in an amount up to \$1,200,000 for the FY 2025 SHIP Homebuyer Education and Counseling RFA. A total of \$209,500 of this funding is set aside as conditional funding to award three (3) partially funded agencies by December 31, 2025. The recommended activities include homebuyer education and counseling services.
- Authorize the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to award funds to the applicants listed in Exhibit A and to execute all necessary letters of commitment, contracts, agreements, and amendments pursuant to the proposed SHIP funding recommendations.

Scope

This funding recommendation for homebuyer education and counseling services will have a countywide impact, benefiting residents across all 13 commission districts. Exhibit A provides the application scores and proposed funding allocations.

Delegation of Authority

This item requests a delegation of authority to authorize the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee to execute all letters of commitment, standard shell contracts, agreements, modifications and amendments pursuant to the proposed SHIP homebuyer education and counseling funding recommendations and to accomplish the purposes set forth in this legislation, to shift funds and funding sources awarded to an activity to any new affiliated entities created for the purpose of carrying out a project, and exercise the termination, waiver, acceleration, or other provisions set forth therein.

This item further requests delegation of authority to authorize the County Mayor or the County Mayor's designee, without returning to the Board, to award \$209,500 in conditional funding to three (3) partially funded agencies, who have funding from 2022 Homebuyer Education and Counseling RFA available to expend. This conditional allocation is contingent upon the agency expending their 2022 allocation by December 31, 2025.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The award of SHIP funds will not have a negative fiscal impact on the County's General Fund. Table 1 summarizes the proposed use of FY 2025 SHIP funding for the seven (7) RFA applications that met the minimum threshold and were forwarded for scoring by the Evaluation/Selection Committee.

Track Record/Monitor

Alex R. Ballina, Director of the Housing and Community Development Department (Department) will oversee all SHIP funded activities. The Department will continue to monitor the activities to ensure compliance with State and County guidelines and policies.

Background

The Department released a draft FY 2025 SHIP Homebuyer Education and Counseling RFA on January 14, 2025, and conducted a technical assistance workshop for potential applicants. The RFA was made publicly available on January 21, 2025, with a submission deadline of February 12, 2025. Public notification of the application process was disseminated through the Department's website and community development email distribution list. Applications meeting the threshold criteria were reviewed and scored by the Evaluation/Selection Committee appointed by the Director of Housing and Community Development.

The FY 2025 SHIP Homebuyer Education and Counseling RFA was issued with a total available funding of \$1,400,000, a total of seven (7) applications were received. Applicants were informed by way of the 2025 RFA Book, if any entity has a remaining available balance from their 2022 Homebuyer Education & Counseling funding allocation, their 2025 recommendation for funding will be reduced by such amount.

As stipulated in the 2025 HBC RFA, in the event a previously awarded applicant/entity has not spent prior year SHIP funds, the applicant/entity will not be recommended for a full funding allocation in this RFA. Applicants who are subject to this scenario and submit an application that rank and score for funding will be recommended for funding based on the max award minus the 2022 award available draw balance at the close of this RFA.

Furthermore, the Department will explore working with other County-led homebuyer education and counseling programs to increase access to homeownership activities.
