In addition, the amendment excludes parks where fishing piers or other devices are either currently in operation or are in the planning stage and are compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act.

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO INSTALL ADAPTIVE FISHING PIERS OR FLOATING DOCKS AT ALL COUNTY OWNED AND OPERATED PARKS WHERE FISHING IS AVAILABLE TO PARK PATRONS, AND TO PROVIDE A REPORT 1(A)(6)

WHEREAS, fishing is an incredibly popular recreational activity for park patrons throughout Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, fishing should be available to all residents of Miami-Dade County regardless

of whether individuals utilize wheelchairs or other mobility aids; and

WHEREAS, currently some of the fishing locations in County parks are inaccessible to

residents utilizing wheelchairs or other mobility aids; and

WHEREAS, adaptive fishing piers and floating docks are engineered and constructed

with the adaptive athlete in mind and incorporate Americans with Disabilities Act features; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires that adaptive fishing piers or floating docks that allow all

residents to fish at Miami-Dade County be installed at County parks,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY

COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

<u>Section 1.</u> Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to install adaptive fishing piers, floating docks >><u>or other devices</u> $<<^1$ at all County owned and operated parks where fishing is available to park patrons to allow park patrons that utilize wheelchairs or other mobility

aids to fish at County parks. >>Parks that currently have or are in the planning phase to install fishing piers or other devices that are compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act shall be excluded from this directive.<<

Section 2. Directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to identify legally available funds in the Fiscal Year 2024-2025 budget for the purpose outlined in Section 1. If the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee is unable to identify legally available funds, the County Mayor or Couty Mayor's designee shall provide a report within 60 days of the effective date of this resolution setting forth the reasons why funds have not been identified or cannot be used or allocated for such purpose, and place the completed report on an agenda of the full Board without committee review pursuant to rule 5.06(j) of the Board's Rules of Procedure.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García. It was offered byCommissioner, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded byCommissionerand upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
