RESOLUTION ELIMINATING FOUR BUDGETED JOB VACANCIES IN COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT OFFICE 4 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025-2026, AND REALLOCATING SUCH FUNDS TO THE COUNTY GENERAL FUND TO BE USED FOR SERVICES IN COUNTY COMMISSION DISTRICT 4, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO FLOOD RELIEF, STORMWATER MANAGEMENT, AND SEPTIC TO SEWER CONVERSION IN DESIGNATED AREAS

WHEREAS, on September 18, 2025, this Board approved the County's budget for fiscal year 2025-2026; and

WHEREAS, this Board desires to reallocate funds from four budgeted job vacancies in County Commission District Office 4 to the Countywide General Fund to be used for certain services in County Commission District 4,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board eliminates four budgeted job vacancies in County Commission District Office 4 for Fiscal Year 2025-2026 (valued at approximately \$300,000.00) and reallocates such funds to the County General Fund to be used for services in County Commission District 4, including but not limited to flood relief, stormwater management, and septic to sewer conversion in designated areas.
