RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO PROVIDE A REPORT PERTAINING TO "THE LEGACY CBOS" (COMMUNITY-BASED ORGANIZATIONS), INCLUDING A HISTORY OF THEIR FUNDING, AN ANALYSIS OF THEIR PROVISION OF SERVICES, AND OTHER FUNDING SOURCES

WHEREAS, each year, the County provides millions of dollars in grant funding to nonprofit and not-for-profit organizations providing human and social services to residents in our community; and

WHEREAS, for nearly a decade, and in some instances over a decade, the community-based organization ("CBO") grant funding managed by the Office of Management and Budget-Grants Coordination Division, has gone to the same list of nonprofit and not-for-profit organizations, known as the "legacy CBOs"; and

WHEREAS, based on the recent adoption of the Fiscal Year 2025-26 County budget, many of the legacy CBOs will receive an additional year of grant funding; and

WHEREAS, in order to make informed decisions about the future of these County grants, this Board desires to have historical information and data pertaining to the legacy CBOs providing services to the community to ensure organizations are not duplicating efforts and are meeting their target goals and outcomes, and have other sources of funding to sustain the organization and programs,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that:

Section 1. The above recitals are incorporated herein by reference and are approved.

Section 2. The Board directs the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to provide a written report to this Board pertaining to the Legacy CBOs that: (1) provides some historical context for how long each organization has received County grant funding and the amount of the grant awards; (2) analyzes the geographic reach, number of residents served, and scope of the services being provided by the organizations, including any duplication of services or officers/staff among multiple CBOs; (3) analyzes the performance of the services offered by the organizations, including a description of the performance goals and outcomes used by the administration to calculate the effectiveness; (4) any other funding it receives from the County; and (5) any other funding the entity receives from state, federal, and private funds. The County Mayor or County Mayor's designee shall provide the report to this Board within 120 days of the effective date of this resolution and place the completed report on an agenda of the full Board without committee review pursuant to rule 5.06(j) of the Board's Rules of Procedure.

The Prime Sponsor of the foregoing resolution is Senator René García and the Co-Sponsor is Commissioner Roberto J. Gonzalez. It was offered by Commissioner _____, who moved its adoption. The motion was seconded by Commissioner _____ and upon being put to a vote, the vote was as follows:
