Subject: Social Equity Statement – Ordinance amending Section 2-1076 of the Code related to the Office of Inspector General - 252448

The proposed Ordinance amends Section 2-1076 of the Code of Miami-Dade County, regarding the Office of the Inspector General (OIG). More specifically, the proposed legislation makes changes to the minimum qualifications for the Inspector General, adds conflict of interest contract requirements, clarifies term limits, and makes changes to the composition of the Ad Hoc Inspector General Selection Committee ("Selection Committee").

The independence of the OIG is fundamental to its work. The inclusion of a member on the Selection Committee from an entity subject to OIG oversight could reduce that independence. Expansion of the eligibility criteria for the selection of the Inspector General could create a larger pool of qualified candidates for consideration.
