RESOLUTION NO. _____

RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF NORTHWEST 137TH AVENUE BETWEEN NORTHWEST 12TH STREET AND NORTHWEST 17TH STREET AS “CEMEX WAY”, URGING THE CITY OF SWEETWATER TO JOIN IN THIS CODESIGNATION

WHEREAS, the Cemex Miami Cement Plant (“Cemex Miami”) was originally established in 1958, and has since continuously produced high quality construction products; and

WHEREAS, Cemex Miami has been a cornerstone of South Florida’s construction industry for decades, playing a critical role in supplying cement for roads, bridges, schools, hospitals, and major infrastructure projects throughout Miami-Dade County and across Florida; and

WHEREAS, as a longstanding member of this community, Cemex Miami takes great pride not only in the materials they produce, but also in the role the company plays as responsible neighbors, having a demonstrated commitment to maintaining and enhancing the areas surrounding their operations, including keeping roadways clean, safe, and well cared for; and

WHEREAS, Cemex Miami is dedicated to continuing fostering stewardship, community partnership, and local investment within Miami-Dade County; and

WHEREAS, that portion of Northwest 137th Avenue between Northwest 12th Street and Northwest 17th Street is a County-maintained road located in the City of Sweetwater; and

WHEREAS, this codesignation is located in County Commission District 12; and

WHEREAS, this Board wishes to recognize Cemex Miami’s contributions to the region and symbolize the company’s continued partnership with Miami-Dade County by codesignating that portion of Northwest 137th Avenue between Northwest 12th Street and Northwest 17th Street as “Cemex Way”,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Having considered this matter at a public hearing, codesignates that portion of Northwest 137th Avenue between Northwest 12th Street and Northwest 17th Street as “Cemex Way”.

Section 2. Urges the City of Sweetwater to join in this codesignation.

Section 3. Directs the Clerk of the Board to send certified copies of this resolution to the Mayor and City Commission of the City of Sweetwater, the United States Postal Service, the Traffic Signals and Signs Division of the Department of Transportation and Public Works, the Development Services Division of the Regulatory and Economic Resources Department, the Sweetwater Police Department, the Miami-Dade Sheriff’s Office, and the Miami-Dade County Fire Rescue Department.
