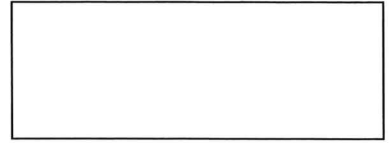

SUBJECT: Resolution Codesignating that portion of Southwest 162nd Avenue from Southwest 232nd to Southwest 240th Street as "Jimmy Ryce Avenue"

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Jimmy Ryce" and noted no adverse findings. OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for "Jimmy Ryce."
