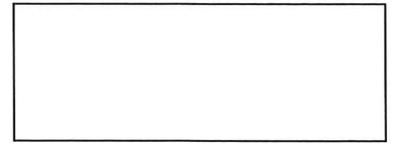

SUBJECT: Resolution approving the City of Miami's codesignation of that portion of Northwest 38th Street between Northwest 17th Avenue and Northwest 15th Avenue as "Lee Corso Way"

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Lee Corso" and the research yielded no conclusive adverse material findings. OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for "Lee Corso." Additionally, as required by Rule 9.02(g)(1), OCA has verified that "Lee Corso" is living. OCA provides this report as a Supplement to BCC Agenda File Item No. 260737.
