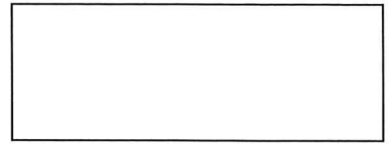

SUBJECT: Resolution codesignating that portion of Northwest 25th Street between Northwest 117th Avenue and Northwest 112th Avenue as “Monsignor Tomás Marín Street” and urging the City of Sweetwater to join in this codesignation

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor’s Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on “Monsignor Tomás Marín” and noted no conclusive adverse material findings. OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for “Monsignor Tomás Marín.” Additionally, as required by Rule 9.02(g)(1), OCA has verified that “Monsignor Tomás Marín” is deceased.
