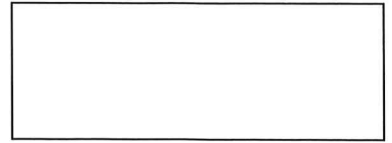

SUBJECT: **Resolution urging the City of Doral to codesignate that portion of Northwest 117th Avenue between Northwest 34th Street and Northwest 25th Street as "Father Elkin Sierra Way"; and approving such codesignation**

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Father Elkin Sierra" and noted no conclusive adverse material findings. OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for "Father Elkin Sierra."
