**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION APPROVING THE CITY OF MIAMI BEACH'S
CODESIGNATION OF THAT PORTION OF VENETIAN WAY, LOCATED
BETWEEN EAST SAN MARINO ISLAND AND WEST RIVO ALTO
ISLAND, AS "JUDGE IRVING AND HAZEL CYPEN WAY"**

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Judge Irving and Hazel Cypen" and noted no conclusive adverse material findings. OCA determined that there is a prior Board County Commissioners (BCC) codesignation related to "Judge Irving Cypen" as follows:

- *R-795-10 - Resolution codesignating Venetian Way from East San Marino Island to West Rivo Alto Island as "Judge Irvign Cypen Way," urging the City of Miami Beach to join in this codesignation*

Additionally, as required by Rule 9.02(g)(1), OCA has verified that "Judge Irving and Hazel Cypen" are both deceased. OCA provides this report as a Supplement to the BCC Agenda File Item No.261416.
