**SUBJECT: RESOLUTION CODESIGNATING THAT PORTION OF SOUTHWEST
84TH STREET BETWEEN SOUTHWEST 97TH ROAD AND SOUTHWEST
103RD AVENUE AS "SERGEANT DAVID CAJUSO WAY"**

Section 2-1 Rule 9.02(g) of the Code requires the Office of the Commission Auditor (OCA) to conduct background research on any person, organization, place, or thing that is the subject of a naming, renaming, or codesignation item, or an item approving the codesignation of state or municipal roads and prepare a report detailing the findings of said research prior to the Commission meeting during which the item is scheduled to be considered.

Commission Auditor's Conclusion:

OCA completed the required background research on "Sergeant David Cajuso" and noted no conclusive adverse material findings. OCA has determined that there are no prior Board of County Commissioners (BCC) codesignations for "Sergeant David Cajuso". Additionally, as required by Rule 9.02(g)(1), OCA has verified that "Sergeant David Cajuso" is deceased. OCA provides this report as a Supplement to the BCC Agenda File Item No. 261414.
