RESOLUTION DIRECTING THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ADVOCACY TO DISPLAY PATRIOTIC CULTURAL, HISTORIC OR ARTISTIC EXHIBITS, DEMONSTRATIONS OR DISPLAYS REPRESENTING THE THEME UNITED WE STAND LOCATED IN OR AT COUNTY OWNED OR OPERATED BUILDINGS AND FACILITIES IN OBSERVANCE OF AMERICAN INDEPENDENCE MONTH DURING THE MONTH OF JULY BEGINNING IN JULY 2017 AND EACH YEAR THEREAFTER; DIRECTING THE OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ADVOCACY TO COLLABORATE WITH THE COUNTY MAYOR OR COUNTY MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO ENCOURAGE ALL COUNTY DEPARTMENTS TO PARTICIPATE OR CONTRIBUTE TO THE UNITED WE STAND PATRIOTIC EXHIBITS, DEMONSTRATIONS OR DISPLAYS

WHEREAS, July 4th as Independence Day honors the birth of the United States of America and the signing of the Declaration of Independence; and

WHEREAS, the date commemorates the adoption of the Declaration of Independence on July 4, 1776, by the Continental Congress, setting the 13 colonies on the road to freedom as a sovereign nation; and

WHEREAS, this most American of holidays is marked every year by patriotic displays, parades, fireworks and backyard barbecues; and

WHEREAS, through passage of Resolution No. 880-09, this Board declared the month of July as American Independence Month; and

WHEREAS, this Board recognizes American Independence Month as a time to honor our founders and their legacy of freedom with gratitude and to remember the sacrifices of our men and women in uniform; and

WHEREAS, this Board would like to further recognize the freedoms we enjoy as Americans and honor the nation's heritage, history, society and people,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF MIAMI-DADE COUNTY, FLORIDA, that this Board:

Section 1. Incorporates and approves the foregoing recitals as if fully set forth herein.

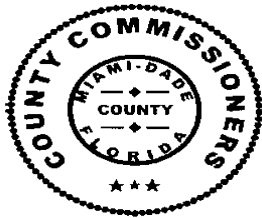
Section 2. Directs the Office of Community Advocacy to display patriotic cultural, historic or artistic exhibits, demonstrations or displays representing the theme "United We Stand" located in or at County owned or operated buildings and facilities in observance of American Independence Month during the month of July beginning in July 2017 and each year thereafter.

Section 3. Directs the Office of Community Advocacy to collaborate with the County Mayor or County Mayor's designee to encourage all County departments to participate or contribute to the "United We Stand" patriotic exhibits, demonstrations or displays.
