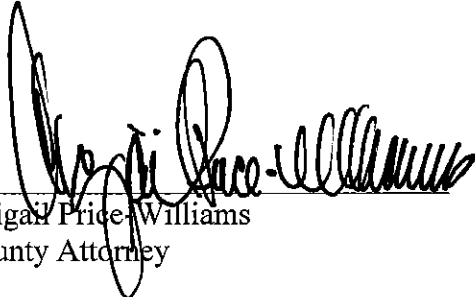

Subject: Resolution Authorizing the Reimbursement of Stolen Tools while Stored on County Property to Rickey Hawkins Pursuant to Section 2-11.13 of the Miami-Dade County Code and Administrative Order 7-23

Recommendation

It is recommended that the Board of County Commissioners (Board) approve the attached resolution authorizing the reimbursement of stolen tools to Rickey Hawkins pursuant to Section 2-11.13 of the Miami-Dade County Code and Administrative Order 7-23. The Miami-Dade Water and Sewer Department (WASD) will reimburse Rickey Hawkins in an amount not to exceed \$3,481.49 for specialized tools that were stolen from his assigned County vehicle while the vehicle was in the Water and Sewer Department's Distribution Garage for brake repairs.

Scope

This item complies with Administrative Order 7-23: Reimbursement to County Employees for Loss of Personal Property and Section 2-11.13 of the Code of Miami-Dade County.

Fiscal Impact/Funding Source

The fiscal impact to the County is in the amount of \$3,481.49. It is a one-time payment to Rickey Hawkins. The funding source is WASD's operating revenue.

Track Record/Monitor

WASD's Chief Financial Officer, Frances G. Morris will oversee the reimbursement to Rickey Hawkins.

Background

Pursuant to the provisions of Section 2-11.13 of the Miami-Dade County Code, it is the policy of the County to provide reasonable reimbursement to its employees for loss or damage to their personal property when that loss or damage was incurred in the discharge of the employee's assigned duties, was not the result of employee negligence and could not otherwise be compensated. The reimbursement is to be used towards the replacement of these tools, whether it is towards a future purchase or reimbursement of replaced tools.

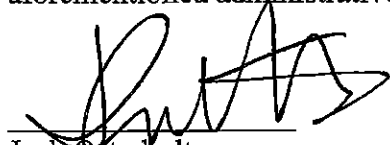
On May 6, 2016, Rickey Hawkins, Plant Maintenance Mechanic, dropped off truck 13-2611 to the Water and Sewer Department Distribution Garage for brake repairs. While repairs were being made, the garage personnel asked Mr. Hawkins for the keys to the bins where the tools were stored to install an inverter. Upon return of the vehicle to Mr. Hawkins a week later, the tools were no

longer in the vehicle. The incident was reported to City of Miami Police and Case Number 160509-139042 was assigned. Mr. Hawkins' supervisor, Aroldo Hernandez, confirmed the value of the tools stolen.

Administrative Order 7-23 clarifies the policy set forth in Section 2-11.13 of the Miami-Dade County Code. Mr. Hawkins' position classification entitles him to reimbursement for the loss of tools upon affirmation of the supervisor that the employee did in fact possess the required tools. Employees in Mr. Hawkins' classification receive a total of approximately \$371 twice a year as a tool allowance to purchase any specialized tools necessary to carry out their work related responsibilities. Mr. Hawkins has been receiving a tool allowance for more than three (3) years. Exhibit A shows the itemized reimbursement tool list.

In presenting this claim for reimbursement, WASD has complied with Section 2-11.13 of the Miami-Dade Code and Administrative Order 7-23, "Reimbursement to County Employees for Loss of Personal Property."

The request for reimbursement for Rickey Hawkins has been approved by the Internal Services Department (ISD) and the Office of Management and Budget (OMB), as required by the aforementioned administrative order. Exhibit B shows ISD and OMB approval.

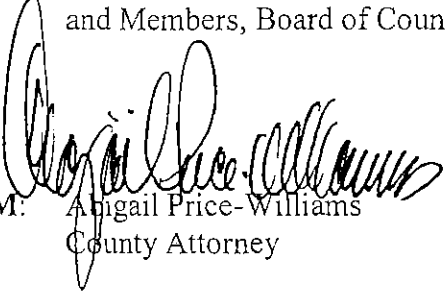

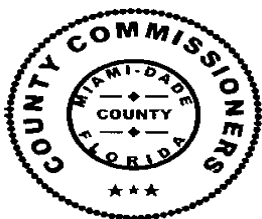
WHEREAS, this Board desires to accomplish the purposes outlined in the accompanying memorandum, a copy of which is incorporated herein by reference,
